Cut-Your-Own & Pre-Cut Christmas Trees Live Balled Trees

The holiday season is almost here, and we warmly invite you to spend some time with us at Sugar Pines Farm! While real Christmas trees are available in many places, nothing compares to the experience of visiting a tree farm, searching for that perfect tree. For over forty years, families have been coming to Sugar Pines, passing down holiday traditions from generation to generation. Whether this is your first visit or your fortieth, we look forward to welcoming you to our farm this season!

Cut-Your-Own Trees

Our picturesque fields are ready for your tree search! With more than 2,000 cut-your-own options, including Canaan fir, blue spruce, and Norway spruce, you'll find trees between 5 and 10 feet tall. (Note: Norway spruce field does not open until 12/6.) For taller trees, plan to visit our tree barn for a variety of great options. We provide saws, sleds, wagons, twine, and a helpful team to bale your tree (please remember, power saws are not permitted). Tree inventory changes daily, so check our website or voicemail for the latest updates!



Live Balled Trees

For a unique option, our live balled & burlapped (B&B) trees can be enjoyed indoors during the holidays, then planted outside to grow for years to come. Choose from over 100 spruce and fir trees, mostly 4–6 feet, along with smaller potted varieties. Visit our website for care and planting tips to see if a live tree is right for your family.

Fresh, Pre-Cut Trees

If cutting your own tree isn't your style, our tree barn offers a wide selection of fresh pre-cut trees, including Fraser fir, Douglas fir, noble fir, Scotch pine, and white pine, ranging from 4 to over 10 feet tall. We work closely with other family-run farms to ensure every tree is freshly cut and carefully selected. This year, our Michigan supplier won the annual national tree contest (voted on by tree growers from across the country) and was chosen to supply the White House Christmas tree — a testament to the quality you can expect!

Seasonal Schedule

Open starting the day after Thanksgiving 9:00 am - 5:30 pm on weekends (and the day after Thanksgiving) 12:00 pm - 5:30 pm weekdays, closed Mondays

TIP: Lines can be long to get in and park the Friday and Saturday after Thanksgiving. If possible, consider visiting later in the day on those days, or during the week for smaller crowds.
